

SALES TAX ORDINANCE

City of Van Buren, Missouri

Ordinance No. 426

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE GENERAL SALES TAX BY ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2 OF 1%) FOR PUBLIC SAFETY PURPOSES TO INCLUDE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND POLICE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO THE ELECTION BALLOT RESULTS DATED APRIL 6, 2021.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Sections 94.500 to 94.550 RSMo, the cities of the state of Missouri are empowered to impose by ordinance, for general purposes, a tax for general revenue purposes on all sellers for the privilege of engaging in the business of selling tangible personal property or rendering taxable services;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 94.500 to 94.550 RSMo., no ordinance enacted pursuant to the authority granted by the provisions of said Sections shall be effective until it has been submitted to the qualified voters of the city and approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting thereon;

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2020, the City of Van Buren, Missouri duly and properly submitted to the qualified voters of the City of Van Buren, Missouri a ballot measure proposing to increase the general sales tax by one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) for public safety purposes including fire department and police department; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the certified election results of April 6, 2021, said ballot measure to increase the general sales tax was passed by the majority of the qualified voters of the City of Van Buren, Missouri;

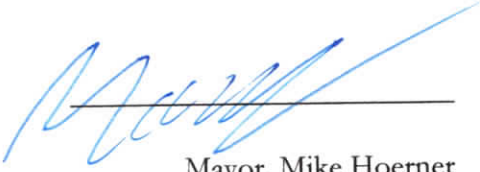

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

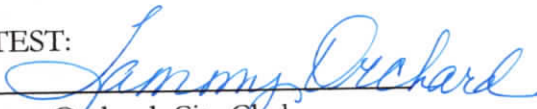
