

ORDINANCE # 432

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE # 425

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Van Buren, Missouri as follows:

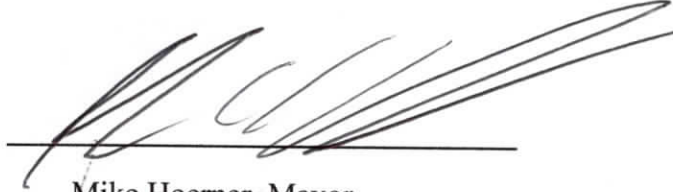
SECTION 10: Any customer with a utility account be it active or vacation water account shall pay their account in full prior to shut off day which is the 25th of each month, unless the 25th lands on a holiday or a Friday. Then it will be the next business day.

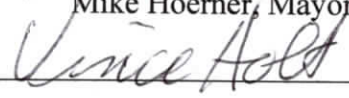
SECTION 11: If said account is shut off due to no payment, before the account can be reconnected the account must be brought current including up to the date of disconnect plus the reconnect fee.

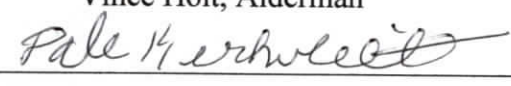
SECTION 12: If said account is not paid before the next billing cycle is created, the account will be closed, and the final bill will be taken out of the deposit on file. If a balance is still owed it will have to be paid before the utilities can be restored. Before utilities are restored the customer will have to fill out a new utility agreement and submit a new deposit.

SECTION 13: If the customer does not bring the account current and it is rental property, the owner of the property is responsible for the bill.

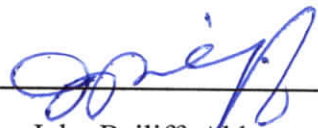

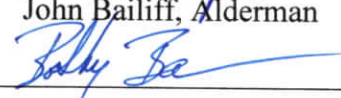
