

ORDINANCE #408

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SALES TAX ELECTION IN THE CITY OF VAN BUREN, MISSOURI

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF
VAN BUREN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: The Board of Aldermen of the City of Van Buren, Missouri (the "City"), finds it necessary to increase its general sales tax pursuant to Sections 94.500 to 94.550, inclusive, RSMo., as amended, by one-half of one percent (0.5%) sales tax on all retail sales made in the City of Van Buren which are subject to taxation under the provisions of Sections 144.010- 144.525, RSMo.

Section 2: The imposition of the sales tax will become effective as provided by law upon approval thereof by a majority of the votes cast on the proposition by the qualified voters of the City voting thereon.

Section 3: A sales tax election is hereby ordered to be held in the City on Tuesday, April 2, 2019, on the following question:

QUESTION

Shall the City of Van Buren, Missouri, be authorized to increase its general sales tax by one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) for municipal purposes?

Section 4: The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to notify the Clerk of the County Commission of Carter County, Missouri, of the adoption of this Ordinance no later than 5:00 pm on January 22, 2019, and to include in said notification of all of the terms and provisions required by Chapter 115 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage and approval.

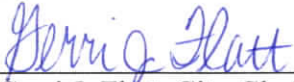
Section 6: Upon passage of the question, the City Clerk shall forward to the Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri by United States certified or registered mail (1) a certified copy of this Ordinance, (2) a copy of the abstract of the votes cast on the proposition at the election and (3) a map clearly showing the boundaries of the City.
